Introduction 5mins	You have already learnt about what seasons produce what foods. However, food does not just get to us overnight! It takes time to produce or grow it – but do you know where some of your common foods come from?	
	Use the chart and cards and decide which one goes where – recommended to work in pairs	
Activity 1 – Planning a garden 15mins	<ul> <li>Activity</li> <li>All the best gardens need to be planned, you will need to consider –</li> <li>What do you want to grow?</li> <li>What space do you have?</li> <li>How would you set it out?</li> <li>What do you already have?</li> <li>What do you need?</li> </ul>	Tape Measure Pens Paper
	Students may like to spend time in the area/garden to get a feel for the space, see what that is already there which can be used, take measurements etc.	
	In groups, get the students to draw out the space and create a layout.
